HISTORY

Mission Peru started with a scouting trip by four youth pastors from the CCD in November of 2007. Out of this trip, the above mentioned partnerships were formed. In the summer of 2008 about 40 people, students with their youth leaders, participated in Mission Peru. In the summer of 2009, 9 more people participated in Mission Peru. 4 youth pastors have participated with their youth groups and two others have scouted the trip. In total, 7 churches have participated from the CCD either through sending their youth, or their youth pastors to scout. This year, we have at least 8 churches participating!

ACCOMODATIONS

There is a group guest house that is run by American missionaries that provides superb housing for short-termers.

A BRIEF REMINDER

- Make sure everyone applies for their passports immediately!
- **Total Cost \$2,100 CAD** Please make cheques payable to: Central Canadian District with Memo marked Mission Peru. You will need to mail a deposit of \$100 per member of your team by December 15th, 2009.
- \$1,000 by March 1st (per team member)
- \$1,000 by May 1st (per team member)

FUNDRAISING ... 1/3rd, 1/3rd, 1/3rd ...

- 1/3rd of the cost for the trip should be “self-funded”, a decision of the person going to buy ownership of their trip, and show their commitment.
- 1/3rd of the cost for the trip should be raised as a team through team fundraisers, such as car washes, dinners, etc.
- The final 1/3rd of the cost of the trip should be fund-raised through personal letters requesting support. These letters should be mailed to people outside the church, such as grandparents, neighbours, teachers, colleagues, friends, etc. (A sample letter template is available upon request outlining details of the project)

TRAINING DATE

All team members are required to attend a Team Training Day that will be held in London, Ontario April 10, 2010, from 10-4pm. (Lunch provided)
